Applications are invited from serving male members of the Force of the rank of Constable/Sergeant who wish to apply the under mentioned course:-

Course

NDA -137 Course at the National Defence Academy, Pune, India from 28th December 2016 to 29th November 2019 (1 slot).

Educational Qualifications

Candidates should possess:-

- (i) A Cambridge School Certificate **OR** a General Certificate of Education 'O' Level, with passes in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at one and same sitting;

and

- (ii) A Cambridge Higher School Certificate **OR** a General Certificate of Education at Advanced Level, with passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" obtained at one and same sitting;

or

Equivalent qualification acceptable to the Disciplined Forces Service Commission (DFSC).

Age

Candidates should **not** have reached their **26th** birthday at the time of joining the training establishment abroad.

Service

Candidates of the rank of Constable should reckon at least three year's service at the closing date of submission of applications.

Fitness and Conditions for eligibility

- (i) Candidates must satisfy the set standards of physical and medical fitness;
- (ii) be medically and psychologically fit;
- (iii) be fluent in English both oral and written;
- (iv) have a good record of conduct and performance; and
- (v) Should be capable of working in difficult and strenuous environment away from home;

Mode of Application

Candidates who qualify for the abovementioned course are required to submit their applications together with photocopies of their educational certificates, birth certificates and other relevant documents to the Staff Officer, Police Headquarters, Line Barracks, Port Louis not later than **Friday 02nd December, 2016 at 1500 hrs.** All applications are to be channeled through Divisional Commander and Branch Officer as regards to the candidates' conduct and performance. Originals of educational qualifications will have to be produced on demand.

Selection Procedure

The Selection Procedures will be carried out in three phases:-


- 1st Phase (Marking 30%) - Candidates meeting the above requirements will be required to undergo a pre-selection test at the Special Mobile Force under the arrangements of the Acting Commanding Officer, SMF. The test includes physical fitness, endurance, swimming and other physical test.
- 2nd Phase (Marking 30%) - Only candidates who successfully pass Phase 1 will be selected for the 2nd Phase which will consist of a series of Command/Leadership tests, Law Procedure, Police duties and Administration which will be carried out by a Selection Board approved by the Commissioner of Police.
- 3rd Phase (Marking 40%) - The best candidates emerging from Phase 2 will be called for an interview before an approved Selection Board constituted and chaired by the Commissioner of Police.

Promotion Prospects

The approval of the Disciplined Forces Service Commission will be sought for the nomination of the selected candidates. The selected candidate will be appointed temporary Inspector of Police during the period of their training at the Indian Military Academy. On successful completion of such prescribed training, they will be eligible for assignment of duties as Inspector of Police for a period of one year in the first instance. At the end of that period, upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Police, they may be considered by the DFSC for appointment as Inspector of Police in a substantive capacity.

Note : The selected candidate will be required to follow a pre-course training at the SMF/PTS prior to departure for the course.

The High Commission has further honour to state that the candidates selected / nominated for the courses should fully meet the qualitative and technical requirements for the specific course as laid down in the training manual/brochure; and have proficiency in English language.

The entitlements of the nominee / trainee under ITEC programme would be as follows:

- Tuition fee,
- Accommodation charges,
- External and Internal tours as per course curriculum,
- Living allowance @ Indian Rupees 25,000/- p.m. for Commissioned Officers, Indian Rupees 21,000/- p.m. for Cadets and Indian Rupees 15,000/- p.m. for Non-Commissioned Officers / Junior Commissioned Officers,
- Medical expenses as admissible, and
- Book Allowance of INR. 400/- per person.

The Living Allowance will be payable for each month in advance from the date of arrival in India to the date of conclusion of the course. The first such advance payment for full month or part thereof, as the case may be, will be made immediately on arrival of the individual in India.





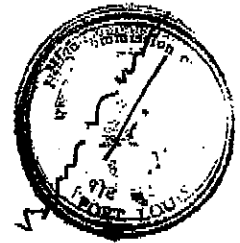
It is requested that the formal acceptance of the training slot may kindly be intimated to the High Commission at the earliest.

- b) Security Clearance Certificate,
- c) Medical Fitness Certificate,
- d) Four (4) copies of passport-size photographs, and
- e) Certificate of Proficiency in English language.
