

Presenting the Airport

Airport Compound covers an area of 625 acres with a perimeter fence of about 12 kilometres. The Runway is about 3.3 kilometres long and 60 metres wide.

The New two Storey Passenger Terminal is a building of 57000 m² and is capable of treating 4.5 million passengers per year.

Our Vision

To make the Airport Police a credible organization capable of providing better service to passengers and members of public using the airport thereby a safer environment.

Our Mission

We, personnel of the Airport Police Formation, take the pledge to faithfully execute and perform all duties incumbent on us in the preservation of peace and the prevention and detection of all offences and all other duties as required of us by law, without fear or favour, affection or ill will.

Structure of Airport Police

The Airport Police is actually under the command of an Assistant Commissioner of Police who has under his charge, one Superintendent of Police, one assistant superintendent of Police, one Chief Inspector, two Inspectors, seven Sergeants, seventeen Corporals, ninety six Police Constables and fifteen Woman Police Constables.

The Airport Police is operating on a 5 Shift-System.

Duties and Responsibilities

- To prevent unauthorised access to Airport Security Restricted Area
- To ensure the integrity of Border Control
- Combatting illegal taxi operation/begging hawkers at the Airport
- To provide security protection and safeguarding of the airport and its infrastructure, vital installations, parked aircrafts, VVIP, travelling passengers, crews, ground personnel and the general public against act of unlawful interference

We undertake to deliver the best policing service to our specific community such as passengers, operators and taxi drivers.

OUR COMMITMENT

We are committed to achieve the Force Priorities through efficient and effective response with a high degree of commitment. In addition we also endeavour to achieve our objectives:

SECURITY TO ALL VITAL INSTALLATIONS

- (i) To provide 24 hrs security at all primary access.
- (ii) To prevent unauthorised access to Security Restricted Area by 100%.

At SSR International Airport among others these Vital Installations need to be protected the SSR Terminal Building, Runway, Control Tower, Perimeter Fence, Aircraft Hangars, Aircrafts, FUEL Depot, Power Station and Generator Plant. We would enhance security to all the vital installation. Patrol by Police Officers are carried out and CCTV are used to provide better security.

SERVICE DELIVERY/ ENQUIRIES/ PHQ'S/ ICT PROJECTS

- (i) Attending to all requests within 15 mins.
- (ii) Reduce number of Outstanding cases by 50%.
- (iii) Ensure 75% of correspondences/ letters are responded to within 21 days.
- (iv) Reply to PHQ's within 15 days as the case may be.
- (v) Reply to PIAC correspondences within five (5) working days.
- (vi) Ensure a 100% usage of Crime Occurrence Tracking System (COTS).

Administrative mechanisms in place at the level of Airport Police play a vital role and has a direct impact on Policing and the quality of service delivery. Therefore, we will ensure that administrative support are optimised in ensuring that objectives set are achieved.

CRIME CONTROL & PUBLIC SAFETY

- (i) Reduce Larceny by 5%.

One of our main Customers at the Airport is Tourist, we do our best to help them in any way so that there "passage" at the Airport go on a smooth way. Airport Police Personnel patrol the Arrival Lounge, Departure Lounge, Traffic areas and personnel are performing CCTV duties so that no one get the chances to steal or pester the tourist and public. Personnel in mufti will support CID to curb larcenies at Airport.

ROAD SAFETY

- (i) Carry out fortnightly Airlock Operations so as to decrease illegal taxi operations.
- (ii) Conduct daily vehicle checks on vehicles entering and leaving airport premises.
- (iii) Conduct monthly sensitisations campaign with all stakeholders, taxi & tourist operators, etc.



ENHANCING PARTNERSHIP WITH STAKEHOLDERS

- (i) Conduct monthly meeting with stakeholders.

Meetings, Seminars and Workshop would be organized with all stakeholders for the betterment and smooth operational activity of the Airport.
